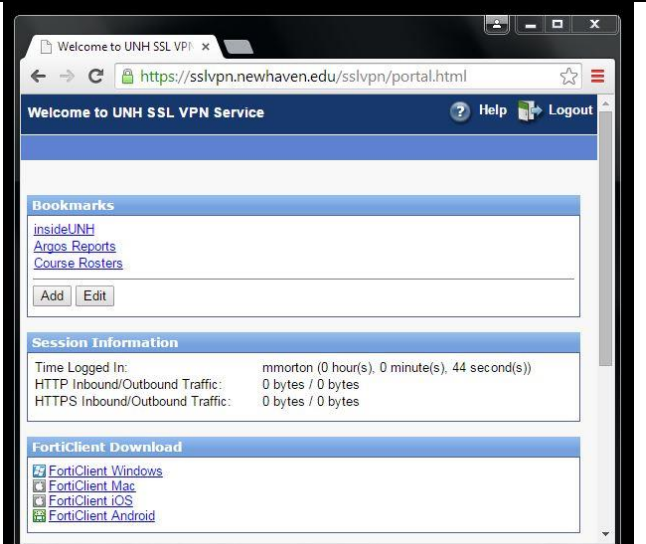


Installing the UNH VPN on your Home Windows Machine

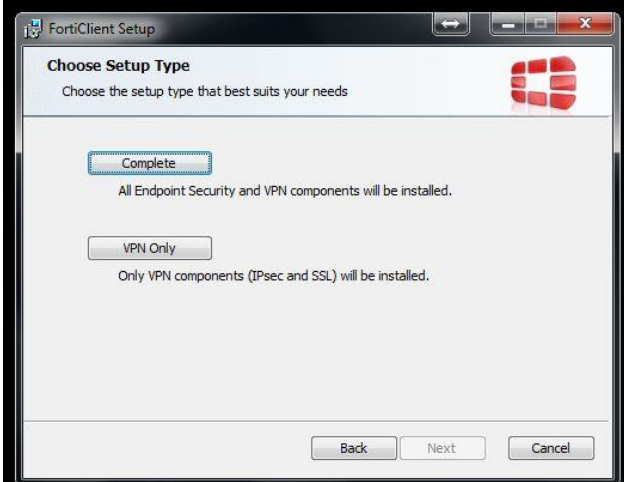
1. Open A web browser and go to <https://sslvpn.newhaven.edu> and log in with your UNH credentials
2. Click on “FortiClient Windows” to download the client software “FortiClientMiniSetup...exe”
3. Once Downloaded, open and run it.



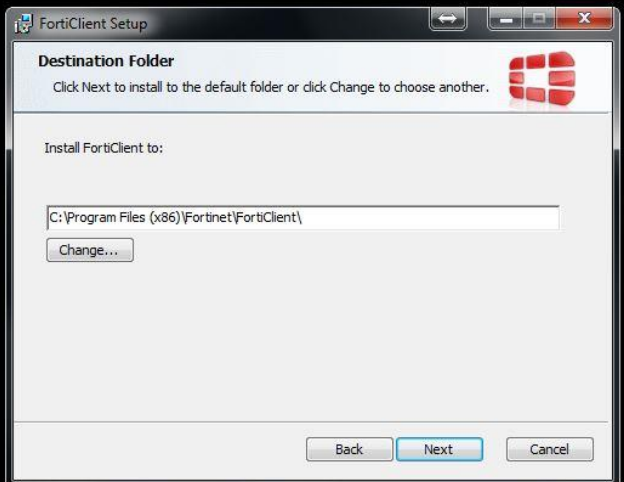
4. Check “Yes, I have read and accept the” license agreement check box
5. Click “next”



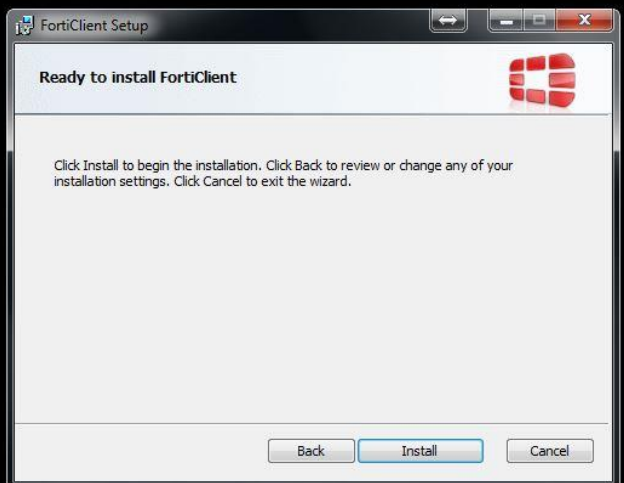
6. Select "VPN Only" and click "next"



7. Click "Next" to accept the default install location



8. Click "Install" to begin the installation

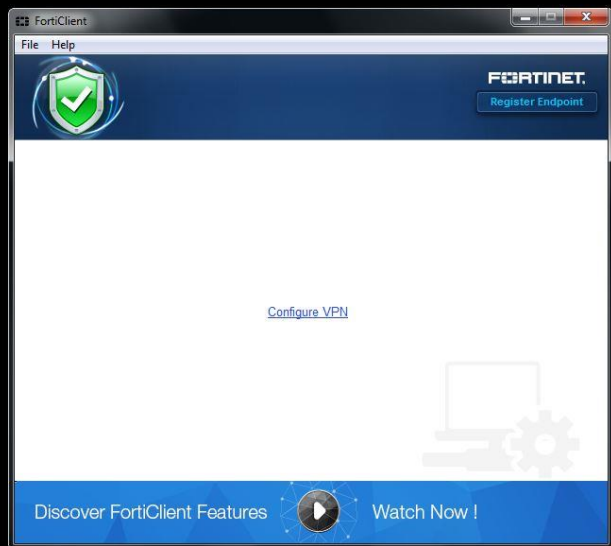


9. When Installation is complete, click “Finish”

10. Click on the “Fortinet Client” icon on your desktop



11. Click on “Configure VPN”

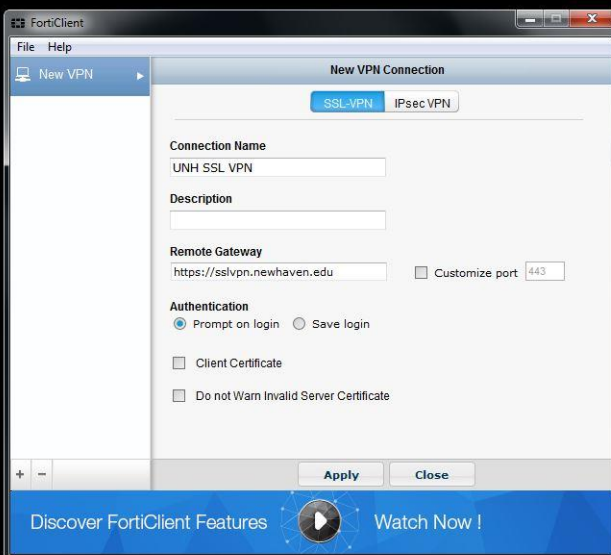


12. For Connection name enter “UNH SSL VPN”

13. For “Remote Gateway” enter <https://sslvpn.newhaven.edu>

14. For “Authentication” select “Prompt at Login”

15. Click “Apply”



16. If all goes well, you should get a window like this one:

17. Enter your UNH credentials and click connect.

You now can access UNH resources remotely. To access your S drive, you will need the address of it from your office machine.
